

**SUMMARY OF REASONS/CHANGES PROPOSED FOR DIVISION 13
(SOLID WASTE PROGRAM) OF THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF
ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ADMINISTRATIVE CODE**

Revisions to the ADEM Administrative Code Division 335-13 are being proposed to amend existing regulations for the beneficial use of by-product materials for the purpose of land application. In addition, new standards and procedures for the operating criteria for Food Processing Residuals (FPR), and FPR Treatment Impoundments are being added.

Amendments to the existing rules include: updating and adding definitions, updating requirements for land application of by-product materials, including Mine-Land Recovery activities, amending registration application requirements to include electronic ADEM Form 569, with the conversion to a three-year registration cycle and fee requirements, amending operating criteria for storage, staging, and land application of by-product materials, and enhancing recordkeeping and reporting requirements. More specifically some of these amendments include: testing requirements for by-product materials similar to 40 C.F.R. § 503, phosphorus rates and limits, notification requirements at commencement and completion of land application activity, and transport and staging requirements when handling FPR.
