Electronic Permit Applications Now Available for Landfill Owners and Operators

MONTGOMERY – In September, the Alabama Department of Environmental Management announced the availability of an electronic notice of intent (e-NOI) process for business owners seeking coverage under the NPDES Construction Permit and that an e-NOI process was being developed for multiple NPDES Industrial General Permits. The first e-NOI for an NPDES Industrial General Permit is now available for the owners/operators of landfills. ADEM strongly encourages landfill owners/operators to participate in this new process that allows certain permit applications to be submitted electronically.

Participation in the e-NOI process enables landfill owners/operators to receive electronic confirmation when their permit application has been received, when their fee payment has been processed, and when their coverage under the NPDES Landfill General Permit has been granted. These features save time, as well as money, for landfill owners/operators and can result in more efficient operations. The e-NOI process also enhances efficiencies within ADEM and allows its staff to operate more efficiently during its processing of permit applications.

The e-NOI process is currently only available for owners/operators seeking coverage under the NPDES Landfill General Permit and the previously announced NPDES Construction General Permit.
