ADEM Partners with Vulcraft Carrier Corporation to Reduce Diesel Emissions

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) is partnering with Vulcraft Carrier Corporation in Fort Payne to utilize funding under the Diesel Emission Reduction Act (DERA) to reduce diesel emissions through an equipment replacement project.

Vulcraft will replace one Tier 1 terminal tractor with a new, more efficient 2018 XSpotter-ACTT42 off road Tier 4 terminal tractor. The Tier 4 terminal tractor is equipped with the most current diesel emissions reduction technology available.

ADEM has awarded Vulcraft \$29,248 through the State Clean Diesel Program to partially fund the project.

The project is scheduled for completion by August 31, 2018.
